Central Drugs Standard Control Organization (CDSCO) in pursuance to implement e-Governance in its offices has launched an online portal 'SUGAM' (www.cdscoonline.gov.in). In the first phase, filing of applications for import and registration of drugs and subsequently, in second phase filing of applications for import and registration of medical devices and diagnostics were already initiated.

The functioning of the portal was reviewed and it has been decided that at the first examination stage of any application either for RC or import license, if in address area, some entries have been filled wrongly or if the drug strength of the drug has been incorrectly filled, at first examination level an email shall be sent to the applicant pointing out the mistake, suggesting the correct way of filling and stating that the application in its present form stands rejected because of the above mentioned issues and the applicant has option to re-apply with the provision that in such cases no fresh fees will be charged.
