In continuation to earlier communications in this regard and in the light of application of Technetium-99 generator for registration for import into India under Drugs and Cosmetics Rules, it is required to draw the samples of first five imported consignments at the port and send it for testing at Radiation Medicine Centre of BARC at Tata Memorial Centre Annex, E-Borges Marg, Parel-Mumbai-400012, India or Institute of Nuclear Medicines & Allied Sciences (INMAS), Lucknow Raod, Timarpur, Delhi-110054, DRDO. The results of testing shall be communicated to CDSCO, HQ by mail, on submission by the importer and declaration by said lab. Consignments shall be released after satisfactory evaluation of results.
